Bag & Venue Entry Policy

Please be aware that we cannot allow customers to bring large bags (size A3 or larger) into the venue. Smaller bags are permitted should they be required by the customer but will be searched on entry by a member of our security team. Beverages and food purchased out with the venue will not be permitted. The venue reserves the right to refuse entry to customers.

Cloakroom

Our Cloakroom accepts cash and card. There is a charge of £2 per item. Please be aware that we cannot guarantee the cloakroom will be open across all events.

While we accept cash, we recommend contactless (limit ± 100) or chip & pin card payments while in our venues.
