There are paintings on the walls and places to sit.



Children can do activity sheets here.

There are cobble stones and plants in the middle of the garden.



There is a smooth surface around the edge of the garden.

There is an exit from the garden onto the street.



There are toilets across the road in St Mungo Museum of Religious Life and Art.



The fire alarm is a bell ringing. Museum staff will guide you out of the building through a fire exit.

Do not go back inside the building unless a member of museum staff tells you that it is safe.
