Our venue toilets are cleaned at regular intervals throughout the day.

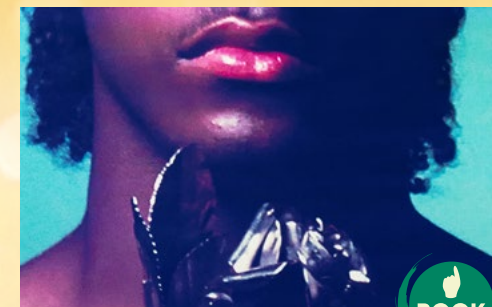

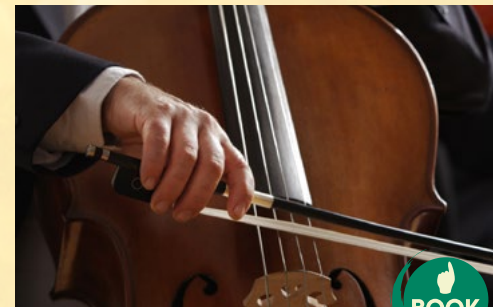
