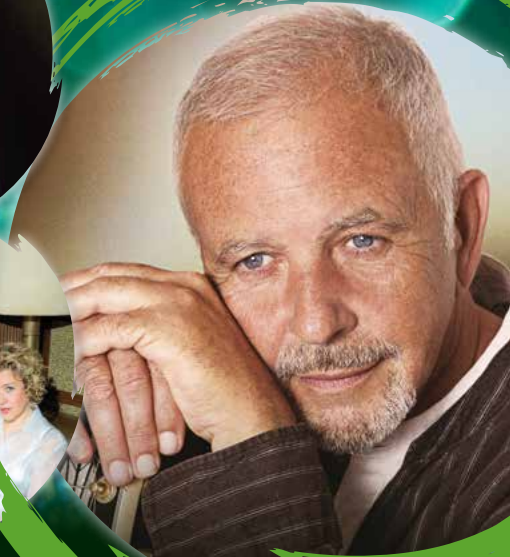

## What to expect when visiting us

### Bag & Venue Entry Policy

Large bags (size A3 or larger) are not allowed in our venues. Smaller bags are permitted but will be searched on entry by a member of our security team.

Beverages and food purchased out with the venue will not be permitted.

The venue reserves the right to refuse entry to customers.

Glasgow Royal Concert Hall has no cloakroom or storage facilities. A paid left luggage facility is present at Buchanan Bus Station on Killermont Street. Their facility is open from 7.30am – 10.30pm.

While we accept cash, we recommend contactless (limit £100) or chip & pin card payments while in our venues.

### Hygiene facilities

Our venue toilets are cleaned at regular intervals throughout the day.
